Completing your application and remitting payment by July 1, 2024. 2) Agreeing to the Rules and Requirements of the event, and 3.) Obtaining the necessary insurance and local food licensing by July 15, 2024. To avoid delays, please complete all the information in this application.

### Food Booth Information:

The approved food truck or trailer space is 10'W x 15'L. However, many food trailers vary in size, and we will try to accommodate your specific needs as best we can. It is our goal to provide a profitable experience for each vendor while offering an interesting and varied array of food options to our attendees. Past participation in our event does not guarantee a future space, or the same location. We select vendors based on the quality of their products, food offerings, and feedback we receive from our attendees and staff.

### Food Permit and Licensing:

A copy of one (1) of the following documents MUST BE PROVIDED BY July 15, 2024.

- 1.) Polk County Department of Health Temporary Restaurant License
  - a. Note: Out-of-State licenses are not valid in Polk County. All holders of this permit shall obtain a Polk County Temporary License
  - b. Note: Wisconsin State temporary licenses are valid in Polk County
- 2.) A regular food service license from the State of Wisconsin (not temporary) or authorized County that shows licensing level as "Mobile"
- 3.) DATCP (Department of Ag, Trade, and Consumer protection) Mobile Food Service license
- 4.) A letter of exemption from the Polk County Health Department acknowledging receipt of food safety training and a list of three (3) exempted days of food services. Contact Brian Hobbs & Polk County Department of Health – 715-485-8532 or [brianh@co.polk.wi.us](mailto:brianh@co.polk.wi.us)

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### Osceola Wheels and Wings Fact Sheet

- The Osceola Wheels and Wings event is **FREE** to the public. Each year the annual celebration attracts more than 8,000 attendees. Arriving early, they take in the sights and sounds of over 100 airplanes that fly in, and early classic car arrivals.
- The event organizers limit both the number of food vendors as well as their offerings to ensure each vendor is in the best position to have an exclusive food offering.
- You will be notified formally of acceptance when application, payment, licensing and food permit have been received. If duplication of food occurs, example, multiple pizza vendors, then vendor who has competed necessary forms first is accepted and duplicate vendor is declined.
- If accepted, you will be mailed a Food Vendor information packet that will include:
  - Event Map, Specific setup instructions, vendor location, and a VIP Parking pass
- A Food Vendor Coordinator will assist you in locating your spot and help with any parking needs.
  - Set up is available the evening prior and is highly encouraged.
- There is no guarantee on vendor locations, but the event coordinators will make every effort to accommodate returning vendors previous location requests
- Food Vendor and Booth Vendor layout is subject to change. The Wheels and Wings event coordinators reserves the right to assign vendor spaces as needed.
